Synopsis:

The brothers Eteocles and Polynices, leading opposite sides in Thebes' civil war, died fighting each other for the throne. Creon, the new ruler of Thebes and brother of the former Queen Jocasta, has decided that Eteocles will be honored and Polynices will be in public shame. The rebel brother's body will not be sanctified by holy rites and will lie unburied on the battlefield, prey for carrion animals, the harshest punishment at the time. Antigone and Ismene are the sisters of the dead Polynices and Eteocles, and along with the Chorus have much to say about this injustice.

Director's Note

As I was preparing to direct Buffalo State University's production of Jean Anouilh's Antigone I was exposed to the work of director Jamie Lloyd, first in a production of the The Seagull in London's West End and then on Broadway in the most recent revival of A Doll's House. Lloyd's direction has a distinctive theatrical style that aims to strip away the traditional trappings of theatrical productions and leave behind the power of the text. I knew immediately that I wanted the students in my cast to learn about this influential director and to experience working in a minimalist style.

In true Jamie Lloyd fashion, our Antigone embraces stark minimalism. The set is a blank canvas - a neutral, hollow space that allows the power of the performances and the weight of the words to take center stage. This approach strips away distractions, forcing the audience to confront the ethical dilemmas and human struggles at the core of the play.

Our production aims to present Antigone in a way that resonates with a diverse, contemporary audience, highlighting the timeless themes of the play -- the power of individual conscience, and the consequences of unyielding pride - in a way that speaks directly to our current political and social climate. We hope to present an Antigone that is both a faithful rendition of Anouilh's powerful adaptation and a fresh, visceral experience for our audience. Thank you for joining us!
